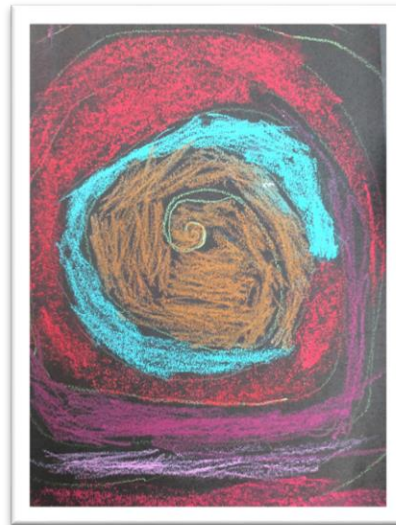
Graham from the Bridport News came today to take a photo of our new starters.



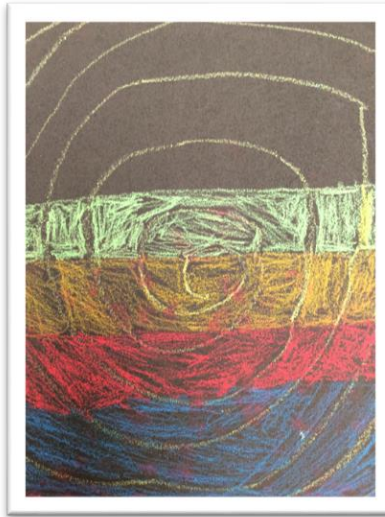
## **Sycamore Class**
