Ancient	Very old; existing for many years.	Democracy	A form of government in which power rests with the people, usually through votes and elections.
Modern	Relating to the present- now	Architecture	The process of designing building, it can be in styles such as Roman or Greek.
BC	An abbreviation for Before Christ written after a date from the past.	Temples	A building or place where a god or gods are worshiped.
AD	An abbreviation for the Latin Anno Domini meaning after the death of Christ.	Pyramids	A stone structure built with 4 faces in the shape of triangles.
Prehistory	A time in history before written history.	Sacrifice	The act of giving up something important to show loyalty or deep love.
Stone Age	A time in history when stone tools were used by humans.	Gods/ Goddess	A being that is worshipped and believed to have special powers over nature or life
Bronze Age	A time in history when the metal was used for tools.	Art	The creation of things that have great beauty or meaning.
Iron Age	A time in history when the metal iron was used for tools and weapons	Religion	Beliefs about how the universe was made and what its purpose is. Religion usually involves worship of a god or gods, and the belief in certain ideas about right and wrong behavior.
Anglo-saxons	People who lived in England before the Normans	Science	A system of studying, testing, and experimenting on things in nature. Science is a search for general laws about how the world works.
Ancient Romans	People who were part of the Ancient Roman Empire.	Maths	The study of numbers, amounts, shapes, and the relationship between them, using symbols to represent these things.
Tudors	People from England in the 15 th and 16 th century	Medicine	The science of identifying and treating disease or injury.
Ancient Egyptians	People from Egypt who lived a very long time ago	Political	To do with the study or practice of politics, politicians, or government.
Ancient Mayans	An ancient Indian civilization of Mexico and Central America that was discovered and destroyed by Europeans in the 1500s.	Social	Related to the way of living now or in the past.
