

Chromebook Guide


If you do not see this screen skip to Step 2

Enter their password into the password box and click next




Go to step 3


Step 2

If you do not see this screen got to Step 3




Step 3

Click the red, green, yellow and blue ball at the bottom




Step 4 – go to classroom.google.com


Having signed into the Chromebook with your child's google log in you should do straight into their classroom. If not and it asks you to sign in, enter their google log in. If you are using the Chromebook with different children you will need to sign them out of the chromebook so the other can log in. To do this click in the bottom right hand corner by the time and then sign out in the top left hand of the box that appears.

Google classroom will look like this, click on your child's Year or Class to view work.




You can see the Assignments set by the teacher here. Click on the assignments to view them






You can always click the three lines in the top left hand corner and then classes to go back to the start screen.
