Mrs Fearn led a special Assembly, and the children drew cards and wrote special messages of thank and hopeful wishes for his future.




Father Keith leaves a big gap in our school community but we will be very pleased to welcome Father Colin next week to help guide us on our continued, mindful, journey with God.
